Recommended action: The Board is asked to accept the monetary tort liability limits for municipalities as set

out in Minnesota Statute 466.04.

Summary:

The District's property and liability insurance is contracted through the League of Minnesota Cities Insurance Trust (LMCIT). The insurance policies are due for renewal on May 24, 2022.

As part of the renewal process the Board of Managers must decide if they wish to waive or accept the monetary limits on tort liability established by Minnesota Statute 466.04. The statute sets the limits for individual recovery at \$500,000 per occurrence and combined recovery for a single occurrence at \$1.5 million for claims arising after January 1, 2009.

In previous actions the Board has accepted the statutory tort liability limits.

WHEREAS,	the District's property and casualty insurance policy is contracted through the League of Minnesota Cities Insurance Trust (LMCIT);

WHEREAS,	EAS, a policy provision on tort liability claims established by Minnesota Statute 466.04 sets the limits for individual recovery at \$500,000 per occurrence and combined recovery for a single occurrence at \$1.5 million for claims arising after January 1, 2009;		
WHEREAS,	EREAS, a board determination must be made to waive or accept these monetary limits on tort liability; and		
WHEREAS,	EREAS, the Board of Managers concurs with the statute provision for public asset protection through the established tort liability limits.

LIABILITY COVERAGE - WAIVER FORM

Members who obtain liability coverage through the League of Minnesota Cities Insurance Trust (LMCIT) must complete and return this form to LMCIT before the member's effective date of coverage. Return completed form to your underwriter or email to pstech@lmc.org.

The decision to waive or not waive the statutory tort limits must be made annually by the member's governing body, in consultation with its attorney if necessary.

Members who obtain liability coverage from LMCIT must decide whether to waive the statutory tort liability limits to the extent of the coverage purchased. The decision has the following effects:

- If the member does not waive the statutory tort limits, an individual claimant could recover no more than \$500,000 on any claim to which the statutory tort limits apply. The total all claimants could recover for a single occurrence to which the statutory tort limits apply would be limited to \$1,500,000. These statutory tort limits would apply regardless of whether the member purchases the optional LMCIT excess liability coverage.
- If the member waives the statutory tort limits and does not purchase excess liability coverage, a single claimant could recover up to \$2,000,000 for a single occurrence (under the waive option, the tort cap liability limits are only waived to the extent of the member's liability coverage limits, and the LMCIT per occurrence limit is \$2,000,000). The total all claimants could recover for a single occurrence to which the statutory tort limits apply would also be limited to \$2,000,000, regardless of the number of claimants.
- If the member waives the statutory tort limits and purchases excess liability coverage, a single claimant could potentially recover an amount up to the limit of the coverage purchased. The total all claimants could recover for a single occurrence to which the statutory tort limits apply would also be limited to the amount of coverage purchased, regardless of the number of claimants.

Claims to which the statutory municipal tort limits do not apply are not affected by this decision.
